ITINERARY

Monday, June 1, 2026 - Scottsdale, Arizona

Flight from a local international airport to Phoenix, Arizona.* Then, enjoy an evening in the resort town of Scottsdale, joining your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner. Hotel: *Courtyard by Marriott Scottsdale* (Dinner)

*Group air schedule is in economy class. Seat assignments are controlled by the airline. Specific seat requests cannot be guaranteed. Air upgrades may be available and are by request only and are not guaranteed. Any air upgrades or deviations must be requested at the time the initial deposit is made.

Tuesday, June 2, 2026 - Scottsdale - Sedona - Grand Canyon

Visit the stunning rock formations of Sedona, before traveling to the Grand Canyon, where you will enjoy the stunning views from seating areas overlooking the canyon. You will also be free to take a short hike to explore individually before dinner. Hotel: *Yavapai East at South Rim Grand Canyon* (Breakfast, Dinner)

Wednesday, June 3, 2026 - Grand Canyon - Lake Powell

Heading to the Carl Hayden Visitors Center, you can enjoy the stunning view over Glen Canyon Dam. Then, arrive at Lake Powell for dinner and sunset views of the lake. Hotel: *Lake Powell Resort, Page, Arizona* (Breakfast, Dinner)

Thursday, June 4, 2026 - Lake Powell - Springdale - Utah

Cross Marble Canyon across the Navajo Bridge on your way to Utah, before stopping in Kanab, the famous filming location for westerns such as The Lone Ranger and Gunsmoke. Then, arrive in Springdale, gateway to Zion National Park. Hotel: *Hyatt Place Springdale* (Breakfast)

Friday, June 5, 2026 - Springdale - Zion National Park - Springdale

Visit Zion National Park and enjoy stunning views from an open air tram, winding along the half-mile wide Zion Canyon. Then, choose to visit the Zion Human History Museum or to explore the park independently. Hotel: *Hyatt Place Springdale* (Breakfast)

Saturday, June 6, 2026 - Springdale - Bryce Canyon National Park - Salt Lake City

Upon reaching Bryce Canyon National Park, you will witness the unique Hoodoo rock formations the park is famous for. Then, take a hike along the Rim Trail to the Sunrise and Sunset Overlook points. Afterwards, drive north to Salt Lake City. Hotel: *Radisson Hotel Salt Lake Downtown* (Breakfast, Dinner)

Sunday, June 7, 2026 - Salt Lake City - Jackson Hole

View the magnificent Bear Lake Summit on your way to the cowboy town of Jackson. Then, on arrival, have dinner and a show with a traditional chuck wagon dinner.* Hotel: *The Lodge at Jackson Hole* (Breakfast, Dinner)

Monday, June 8, 2026 - Jackson Hole

Enjoy Jackson Hole at your leisure, with activities available ranging from independent hiking to shopping and cuisine. Hotel: *The Lodge at Jackson Hole* (Breakfast)

Tuesday, June 9, 2026 - Jackson Hole - Grand Teton & Yellowstone National Parks

Pass through Grand Teton National Park, rising nearly a mile above the valley of Jackson Hole. While there, you will see the Teton Range, the youngest range in the Rockies. Then, you will arrive at Yellowstone National Park** and explore the sights, including the famous Old Faithful Geyser. Hotel: *Buffalo Village Holiday Inn and Cabins* (Breakfast)

Wednesday, June 10, 2026 - Yellowstone - Cody - Sheridan

Take a trip through Yellowstone over the Sylvan Pass, passing through Cody where you will stop at the Buffalo Bill Center of the West. You will also drive through the towering Bighorn Mountains and the territory of the Great Sioux Nation, before turning in upon reaching Sheridan. Hotel: *Best Western Sheridan Center* (Breakfast)

Thursday, June 11, 2026 - Sheridan - Rapid City, South Dakota

You will see the Crazy Horse Memorial and visit the Native American Cultural Center to learn more about local customs. Afterwards, see the iconic Mount Rushmore, then meet a local Lakota Native American during dinner. Hotel: *ClubHouse Hotel & Suites, Rapid City* (Breakfast, Dinner)

Friday, June 12, 2026 - Rapid City

Your tour comes to a close, with a return from Rapid City to a local international airport.* (Breakfast)

Tour Activity Level: 3

GENERAL INFORMATION

Travel Documents

U.S. State Department and destination specific travel regulations at time of brochure printing require the following documents for your travel, a valid government issued REAL ID or passport. Travel regulations and state compliance requirements are subject to and have been known to change. For the most current requirements, which due to potential changes may be other than what is listed here, please consult with your Travel Advisor.

Travel Requirements

As travel policies are rapidly changing, final requirements will be communicated prior to departure. Please see your Travel Advisor for additional information.

Baggage

Due to limited space while touring, all passengers are limited to one checked bag no more than 50lbs. You may also bring a small carry-on bag small enough to fit under your seat. Soft sided carry-on bags no larger than 17"x14"x4" with a zippered enclosure are recommended. Wheeled carry-on cases that are used as carry-on luggage on airlines are too large and are not suitable as hand-carried luggage. Baggage fees are not included in the price of the trip. Baggage fees and other charges may be directly assessed by the airlines or airport.

Cancellation Penalties

A deposit of \$698 per person is due at the time of booking.

Flight
