Depart Central, PA by motorcoach and travel to the Conrail Museum with a rest stop en-route.

**Early morning departure- exact timing will be confirmed closer to travel.

Arrive at the **Conrail Museum**. Members of the museum will be available to discuss the museum exhibit as well as answer questions. Learn about the 50th Anniversary of Conrail and view archives that are normally closed to the public. The PRR signal from Horseshoe Curve will be outside and available for viewing.

Enjoy lunch at **Knute's Tap Room**. There will be a select menu to choose from including dessert and a non-alcoholic beverage. After lunch, arrive at **East Broad Top Railroad** with time to look around the gift shop and a comfort break before boarding the train for an hour long ride. Following, take a ride on the **Rockhill Trolley Museum Trolley** (located across from East Broad Top Railroad).

End the day with a guided tour of the **Historic Belt Driven Machine Shop Complex** at East Broad Top Railroad. Depart for home with a dinner stop along the way (dinner is not included in the price of the trip). (Lunch)
