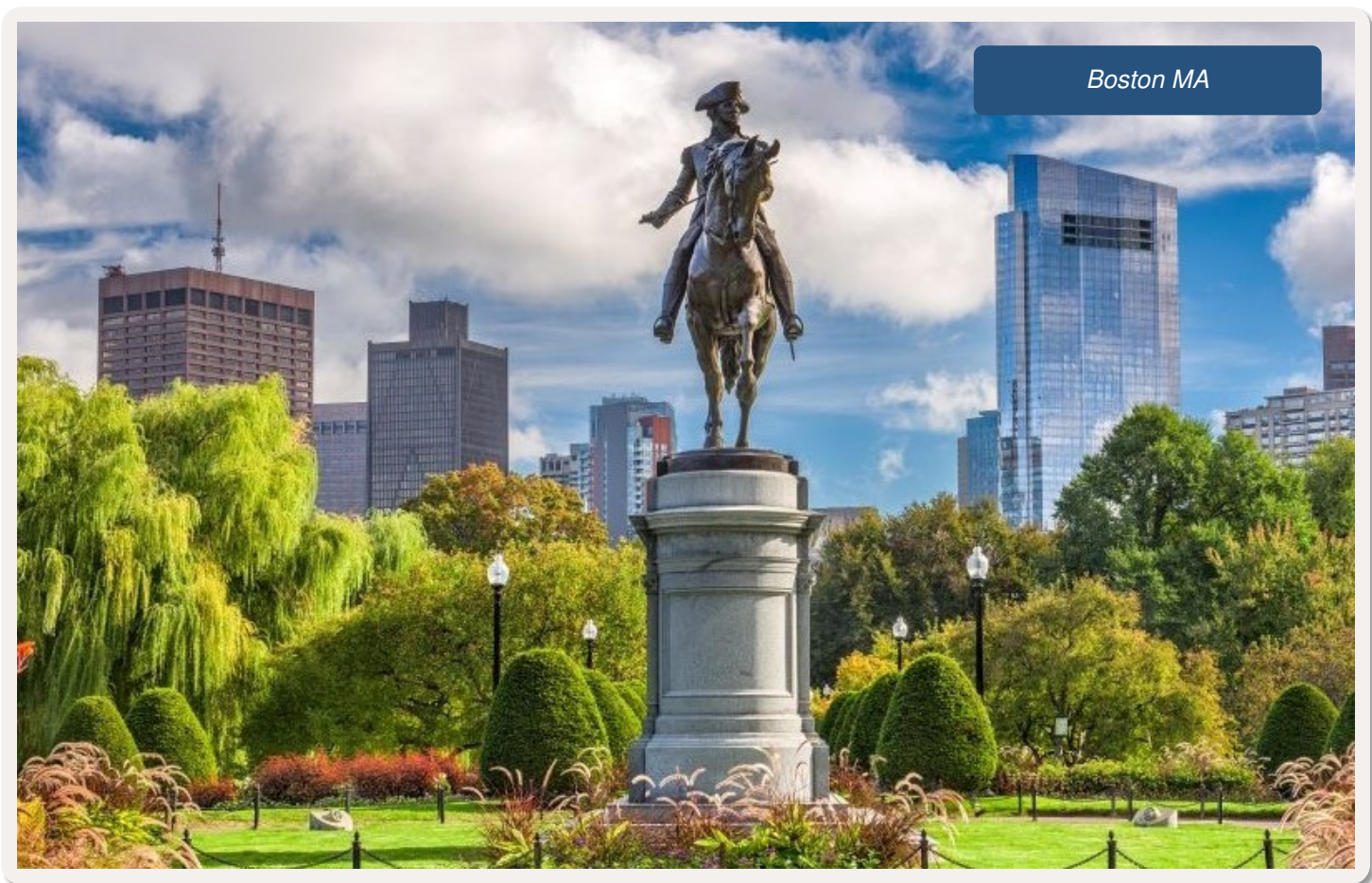

HIGHLIGHTS

Boston, MA

Boston is a tapestry of historic grandeur and modern charm. Cruising into this port, guests can explore the Freedom Trail or relish the cosmopolitan air of this city's bustling streets. With every step on the cobblestone paths, the echoes of America's past blend with the vibrant rhythms of contemporary city life.

Fun Things to Do:

- Enjoy the highlights of Boston from both land and sea on this unique panoramic sightseeing tour of the city's most important and scenic sites via a replica World War II amphibious vehicle called the Boston Duck.
- Visit one of the city's most attractive spots, Copley Square, bordered by the architectural wonders of Trinity Church and the Boston Public Library.
- Walk the Freedom Trail to see many highlights of Boston -- the Massachusetts State House, Park Street Church, and the Granary Burying Ground, the final resting place of many famous Americans, including John Hancock, Samuel Adams, and Paul Revere.

St John, New Brunswick

Saint John, on the southern coast of New Brunswick, is Canada's oldest incorporated city as well as the only city on the Bay of Fundy.

Fun Things to Do:

- Stroll through uptown Saint John which visits historic attractions like the 1784 Burial Grounds, the 1876 Old City Market, a general store and the Jewish Historical Museum.
- View the point at which the Bay of Fundy and the Saint John River collide: the Reversing Falls Rapids.
- Visit the beach, where time and tides have carved echoing caves in the sandstone cliffs. Enjoy a walk along the sand and some seafood chowder at the beach restaurant.

Norfolk, VA

Norfolk is a 400-year-old seaport that is home to one of the best maritime schools in the country and one of the most extensive naval

bases in the world. Maritime enthusiasts will have plenty to explore.

Fun Things to Do:

- Tour USS Wisconsin and get to know this impressive battleship that earned five battle stars during WW II.
- Visit Nauticus, a nearby maritime discovery center that tells the story of the industry and military with interactive exhibits.
- Enjoy the Norfolk Botanical Garden that offers a respite for nature-lovers with walking paths and trams that wind through various types of lavish gardens.

New York, NY

New York, a city of dazzling contrasts and vibrant diversity, promises an unparalleled experience. Explore iconic art museums, historic buildings, and sweeping parks, and indulge in legendary shopping and dining. Whether you're taking in the skyline from an observation deck, catching a Broadway show, or crossing the Brooklyn Bridge, the NYC cruise port is your gateway to endless exploration.

Fun Things to Do:

- Enjoy a scenic drive through Manhattan. You'll view the Rockefeller Center, Times Square, the Theatre District, the Empire State Building and St Patrick's Cathedral.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Travel Documents

U.S. citizens on homeport cruises (cruises that begin and end at the same U.S. port) are currently able to enter or depart the country with a state issued birth certificate with a raised seal and government-issued photo ID. A government issued photo ID that is REAL ID compliant is required for airport security. AAA recommends traveling with an original, signed passport valid for 6 months beyond stay, and with at least one blank visa page for visa stamp(s).

As travel policies are rapidly changing, the final travel requirements will be communicated prior to departure. Please see your travel advisor for additional information.

Insurance
