Monday, December 7, 2026 - Overnight Flight

Transfer by motorcoach from Central PA to a local international airport for an overnight flight.

Tuesday, December 8, 2026: Innsbruck, Austria

Arrive in the town of Innsbruck, in the heart of the mountains. The day is yours to enjoy at your leisure, and in the evening take in a welcome dinner with your fellow travelers. Hotel: *Hotel Grauer Bar, Innsbruck* (Dinner)

Wednesday, December 9, 2026: Innsbruck - Seefeld- Innsbruck

In the morning, **it's your choice!** choose between a locally guided tour of Innsbruck, **OR** a visit to the Museum of Tyrolean Regional Heritage. Then, take a train to the village of Seefeld, where you'll take an authentic horse-drawn carriage into town, and participate in the making and eating of traditional strudel. Thursday, December 10, 2026: Innsbruck - Salzburg - Innsbruck

Journey to the Old Town of Salzburg**, famous for the birthplace of Mozart and the "Do-Re-Mi steps" from *The Sound of Music.* Enjoy a free afternoon to explore the town, and visit any of the six local Christmas Markets. In the afternoon, visit St. Peter Stiftkulinarium, the oldest continuously-serving restaurant in Europe. Hotel: *Hotel Grauer Bar, Innsbruck* (Breakfast, Dinner)

Friday, December 11, 2026: Innsbruck

Enjoy the day at your leisure in Innsbruck. Visit the Christmas Markets, and enjoy local brass bands and culinary treats. You also have the option to take in a Tyrolean dinner and folklore show in the evening. Hotel: *Hotel Grauer Bar, Innsbruck* (Breakfast)

Saturday, December 12, 2026: Innsbruck - Oberammergau, Germany - Innsbruck

Tour Linderhof Palace, the only palace that King Ludwig II lived to see completed. Walk the halls with an expert guide, and take in royal luxury. Then, enjoy a local lunch before taking the time to independently explore the Bavarian village of Oberammergau. Hotel: *Hotel Grauer Bar, Innsbruck* (Breakfast, Lunch)

Sunday, December 13, 2026: Innsbruck - Munich, Germany

Return to Munich, where you can see the Glockenspiel***, with life sized figurines spinning and dancing. Then enjoy free time in the city, where you can visit one of Europe's largest Christmas Markets. Afterward, join a local guide on a tour of Munich, seeing sites such as the Royal Square and Parliament Building, before ending your day with a farewell dinner. Hotel: *Movenpick Hotel Munchen Airport, Munich* (Breakfast, Dinner)

Monday, December 14, 2026: Munich - Central PA

Your tour ends today with a flight home from Munich to a local international airport.

This activity level is not recommended for travelers with significant mobility concerns.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Travel Documents

Original, signed passport valid for 6 months beyond stay, and with at least one blank Visa page for Visa stamp(s) is required for this trip.

As of the printing of this brochure all guests are required to obtain an ETIAS (European Travel Information and Authorization System) travel authorization for travel to Europe's Schengen zone (not included in the price of the trip). Please see your Travel Advisor for additional information.

As travel policies are rapidly changing, final requirements will be communicated prior to departure. Please see your Travel Advisor for additional information.

Baggage

Due to limited space while touring, all passengers are limited to one checked bag no more than 50lbs. You may also bring a small carry-on bag small enough to fit under your seat. Soft sided carry-on bags no larger than 17"x14"x4" with a zippered enclosure are recommended. Wheeled carry-on cases that are used as carry-on luggage on airlines are too large and are not suitable as hand-carried luggage. Baggage fees and other charges may be directly assessed by the airlines or airport.
