### **Travel Documents**

Original, signed passport valid for 6 months beyond stay, and with at least one blank visa page for visa stamp(s). \* Canada reserves the right to deny entry to anyone with a felony conviction, including a DUI record. AAA is not responsible if you are denied entry to Canada and no refund will be provided.

### **Payment**

Deposit of \$600 per person/\$1200 per cabin will confirm your reservation. Final payment is due to AAA by April 19, 2020. Solo Travelers Rewards Club maximum voucher redemption: \$100

### **Cancellation/Penalties**

Deposit date to day of departure \$25 per person, plus...

From May 19 – June 6, 2020 \$600 per person/\$1200 per cabin, plus any additional suppliers' fees

From June 7 – July 4, 2020 50% of gross fare per person, plus any additional suppliers' fees

From July 5 – 17, 2020 75% of gross fare per person, plus any additional suppliers' fees

### **Insurance**

For your protection AAA recommends travel insurance. Pre-existing medical conditions may be waived with proper coverage if travel insurance is purchased within 14 days of initial deposit only. Other conditions may apply; ask your travel agent. AAA recommends Allianz.

### **Flight**

Air arrangements are handled by the tour operator. Seat assignments cannot be confirmed until the tour operator releases names to the airline(s) 30 days prior to departure. Specific seat requests cannot be guaranteed. Some flight schedules may contain code share agreements.

### **Clothing/Climate**

Alaska is not a frigid land of ice and snow! The interior around Fairbanks is warm during the summer. Pack for a variety of temperatures; layers work best.

Daytime, casual clothes and comfortable walking shoes are fine. For cruising, evenings require casual or semi-formal attire, with two formal nights.

## **Baggage**

Due to limited facilities, charter airline regulations for flights between Fairbanks and Dawson City restrict passengers to two checked bags with a maximum combined weight of 50 lbs. and one carry-on item under 13 lbs. All fees for exceeding those limits will be the traveler's responsibility. Soft sided tote bags no larger than 17"x14"x4" with a zippered enclosure are recommended. Wheeled carry-on cases that are used as carry-on luggage on airlines are too large and are not suitable as hand-carried luggage on motorcoaches or trains. Baggage fees and other charges may be directly assessed by airlines or the airport.

## **Travel Assistance**
