

### Saturday, December 4: Depart USA

Motorcoach from Central PA to a local international airport for an overnight flight to Munich, Germany.

### Sunday, December 5: Arrive in Munich

Welcome to Germany! Transfer from the airport to Vilshofen to board the beautiful **AmaBella** for your 7-night Christmas Markets cruise on the Danube River. This afternoon join Vilshofen locals and fellow guests for a glass of beer and a traditional German pretzel ashore at a festive Oktoberfest celebration.

### Monday, December 6 - Passau, Germany

During the season of Advent, beautiful Passau dresses in her Bavarian holiday splendor, which you will discover on your walking tour through the city and at its Christmas market at St. Stephen's Square, also home to its magnificent cathedral. The market is full of unique crafts, including Bavarian-style houses and glass ornaments.

### Tuesday, December 7: Linz, Austria

Linz is known for being the city of Christmas crèches and its popular Linzer torte. In the morning choose between a walking tour through Linz's old city center and by the Mozart House, or a guided bike tour along the Danube River. Alternatively, enjoy a full-day in Salzburg with a walking tour in the historic center, famous for its religious history, Baroque architecture, and the birthplace of Mozart. While there, visit the beautiful Christmas Markets which are renowned for local crafts and holiday presents.

### Wednesday, December 8: Weissenkirchen, Austria

Today, enjoy a walking tour in Dürnstein and visit the magnificent Benedictine Abbey of Melk. For a more active adventure, bike along the Danube River or hike up to Dürnstein Fortress where Richard the Lionheart was once held captive and enjoy incredible views of the river and the village below. You can also choose to visit a local boutique where you'll enjoy a tasting of special apricot treats.

### Thursday, December 9: Vienna, Austria

Welcome to the City of Waltzes! Vienna offers a treasure of gems just waiting to be discovered. Join a tour showcasing its regal splendors, such as the majestic Opera House and the former Imperial Palace of the Habsburgs before concluding in Vienna's historic city center. Spend the afternoon at the Schonbrunn Christmas Markets and catch a glimpse of the giant sparkling Christmas tree, followed by a free evening on your own.

### Friday, December 10: Vienna, Austria

Today, enjoy a Bratislava city tour, including a visit to Bratislava's charming Christmas Market. There is also a choice to take an invigorating castle hike from Vienna up to Bratislava castle to see sights such as the treelined Hviezdoslav Square, the narrow House of the Good Shepherd, Michael's Gate and the Old Town Hall. In the evening explore Vienna's festive Christmas Markets.

### Saturday, December 11: Esztergom-Budapest, Hungary

Home to several UNESCO World Heritage Sites, Budapest offers an unmatched combination of culture and tradition. Visit Vorosmarty Square, the oldest, richest and the most spectacular of all the Christmas markets in Budapest.

### Sunday, December 12: Budapest- Disembarkation

This morning disembark the ship and transfer to the Budapest airport for your flight and transportation back to Central, PA.
