ITINERARY

Friday, February 10: Travel to Montreal

6:00AM: Motorcoach will depart from Lancaster, from the former AC Moore store, located 1515 Lititz Pike at the Lancaster Shopping Center on the Oregon Pike/ Route 272 side of the store.

7:00AM: Depart from Harrisburg, AAA Central Penn, 2301 Paxton Church Rd; travel to Montreal with appropriate rest and meal stops en-route. Check into the hotel with time to freshen up before a delightful dinner at a local restaurant. The remainder of the evening is at your leisure to venture out and experience Montreal on your own. Hotel: *Hampton Inn by Hilton, Montreal, QC. Downtown (Dinner)*

Saturday, February 11: Travel to Quebec City, Hôtel de Glace (Ice Hotel), Night Parade

GENERAL INFORMATION

Travel Documents

Original, signed passport valid for 6 months beyond stay, and with at least one blank Visa page for Visa stamp(s). A government-issued photo I.D (such as a driver's license) is required for this tour.

As of the writing of this brochure, all travelers must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 with the last dose having been administered at least 14 days prior to departure to travel to Canada. Additional COVID-19 related requirements including pre-entry or return to U.S. testing may be required. As travel policies are rapidly changing due to COVID-19, final requirements will be communicated prior to departure.

*Canada reserves the right to deny entry to anyone with a felony conviction, including a DUI record. AAA is not responsible if you are denied entry to Canada and no refund will be provided.

Payment

\$300 per person deposit due at the time of booking to confirm your reservation. Final payment is due to AAA by **December 9, 2022**.

Cancellation/Penalties

A \$25 per person cancellation fee will be charged by Discoveries in addition to any other supplier's fees. From **December 9, 2022** to day of departure no refunds.

Insurance
