Safety Tips for Solo Travelers

Traveling solo is fun and sometimes an adventure but it doesn't have to be stressful. Keep these tips in mind before you leave on your next trip.

- Share your itinerary with a family member or friend before you leave and keep them updated. Check in periodically.
- Be careful about exposing the length of time you'll be away on social media. Post Facebook photos after you return from you trip.
- Stop your mail or newspaper delivery so it's not stacking up until you return home.
- Have a friend or trusted neighbor watch your home while you are gone.
- When packing for your trip place your identification and contact info inside your luggage as well as outside.
- Call your bank and credit card company before you leave home and let them know where you will be and for how long so your funds will remain available to you. And if your plans change, keep them updated.
- While traveling, never share with a stranger or new friend that you are traveling alone.
- Try not to look lost, even if you are. Discreetly, off to the side, pull out your map or smart phone and get your bearings.
- If you are traveling by yourself on a group tour tell someone (group leader) if you plan to do something or go somewhere apart from the group or venture off at night on your own.
- Be aware of your surroundings. Avoid dark streets and alleys or vacant areas.
- If rooming alone use the double door locks and never open your door if you aren't expecting a visitor. Call the front desk to verify staff coming to your room if you didn't request service.
- Always consider purchasing travel insurance to protect yourself while enjoying your trip.
- If traveling internationally there is a free service provided by the US Department of State that allows travelers to enroll their trip with the nearest US Embassy or Consulate. It's called Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (STEP for short). You receive automatic alerts in the event of an emergency, natural disaster, civil unrest or a family situation. Go to: https://step.state.gov/step/

If you plan for the unexpected you will be ready for whatever comes your way.
