Daily Itinerary

Friday, April 30, 2027 – Travel to Dearborn, Michigan

Depart Central Pennsylvania by motorcoach for Dearborn, Michigan. Appropriate comfort and meal stops will be made along the way. Upon arrival, check into the Hampton Inn Dearborn for an overnight stay before enjoying a group dinner at Roman Village Restaurant. *Hotel: Hampton Inn Dearborn (Dinner)*

Saturday, May 1, 2027 – Dearborn to Holland Michigan

After breakfast, depart for Holland, Michigan, home of the nationally renowned Tulip Time Festival. Upon arrival, enjoy a traditional Dutch lunch and dance performance before embarking on a guided city tour led by a costumed local guide who will share Holland's fascinating history and Dutch heritage. Later, check into the Hampton Inn Holland for a three-night stay. This evening, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant followed by a Tulip Time show. *Hotel: Hampton Inn Holland* (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Sunday, May 2, 2027 – Tulips, Tradition, and Windmills

After breakfast, experience the Tulip Immersion Garden, featuring more than 50,000 tulips displayed in stunning raised gardens that showcase the history of the tulip from Turkey to the Netherlands and ultimately to Holland, Michigan. Continue to Nelis' Dutch Village, where authentic Dutch architecture, costumed interpreters, wooden shoe carving, Dutch dancing, cheese making, and other cultural demonstrations bring Dutch traditions to life. Enjoy free time for lunch before visiting beautiful Windmill Island Gardens. This evening, relax aboard a scenic Holland Princess Dinner Cruise. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Monday, May 3, 2027 – Grand Rapids - Evening Tulip Time Show

This morning, travel to Grand Rapids for a tram tour of the Frederik Meijer Gardens & Sculpture Park, one of the Midwest's premier botanical and sculpture destinations. Return to Holland and after free time for lunch, visit Dutch Life on Display at the historic Van Raalte Farmhouse, where authentic garments and artifacts from the Dutch Costume Museum of Amsterdam showcase the rich history and traditions of Dutch settlers. Conclude the day with a special Tulip Time dinner venue and festival show (both TBD). (Breakfast, Dinner)

Tuesday, May 4, 2027 – Holland to Youngstown, Ohio

Following breakfast, depart Holland and travel to Youngstown, Ohio. Along the way, enjoy free time for lunch before visiting the beautiful Fellows Riverside Gardens. Featuring more than 40,000 spring bulbs, colorful seasonal displays, roses, and scenic vistas, these award-winning gardens are among Ohio's finest public gardens. This evening, check into the DoubleTree by Hilton Downtown, Youngstown. This evening is on your own to relax and enjoy one of the local restaurants for dinner. *Hotel: DoubleTree by Hilton Downtown Youngstown* (Breakfast)

Wednesday, May 5, 2027 – Return to Central Pennsylvania

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and begin the journey home to Central, PA. Appropriate comfort and fast-food meal stops will be made along the route as you reflect on the wonderful memories and colorful experiences of Michigan's Tulip Time Festival. (Breakfast)

Do I need Travel Insurance?

How many bags may I bring?

One suitcase per person will be allowed. You may also bring a small carry-on bag.
