Labadee, Haiti

Saturday, January 30, 2027

Charlotte Amalie, St Thomas

Charlotte Amalie is one of the world's most beautiful harbors; blue waters peppered with sailboats and green hills dotted with quaint little cottages make for post-card perfect brags. Just outside the lively port town, you'll find ribbons of powdery sand beaches dotted with hammocks. St. Thomas may technically be part of the U.S., but with its colorful markets, unspoiled beaches, and the ever-present sound of steel drums, you'll feel a world away.

Fun Things To Do:

Fun Things To Do:

- Enjoy snorkeling and water skiing. Then move on to a beautiful sandy beach for more fun in the water.

- Experience the rich history, unique culture and tropical flora of St. John's on an informative Antigua Island Tour.

Monday, February 1, 2027

Castries, St. Lucia

Philipsburg, St. Maarten
