Tuesday, March 2, 2027

Friday, March 5, 2027

Puerto Plata, Dominican Republic

Arrive at 11:00 am – Depart at 6:00 pm

Puerto Plata (or officially known as San Felipe de Puerto Plata) is the ninth largest city in the Dominican Republic and the capital of the province of Puerto Plata. For spectacular city views, take a ride up the Pico Isabel de Torres mountain which stands over 2,600 feet high. History buff? Visit Fortaleza San Felipe, which was built in the 16th century and served as a prison under the dictatorship of Rafael Trujillo.

Fun Things To Do:

- Stop at key attractions within Puerto Plata's 60-block historic city center.
- Tour a rum factory, browse artisan shops and meander through Central Park.
- Browse a museum dedicated to a national hero and another full of amber artifacts.

Saturday, March 6, 2027

San Juan, Puerto Rico

Arrive at 10:00 am – Depart at 6:00 pm

Puerto Rico's vibrant capital, San Juan, offers 500 years of history and culture to explore. Roam ancient fortresses and colorful colonial-era buildings. Dig into flavorful criolla cuisine and reggae beats— the city is a kaleidoscope of new experiences waiting to be discovered.

Fun Things To Do:

- See Baño Grande, a natural swimming pool. Then take a walk on Caimitillo Trail and look for the artificial nest of the Puerto Rican parrot and the flora and fauna of the Palo Colorado forest.
- Explore Old San Juan, the second-oldest European settlement in the New World.
- Bike through the gorgeous scenery of the Piñones Reserve, home to the island's most spectacular view

Sunday, March 7, 2027

St. Thomas, US Virgin Islands

Arrive at 7:00 am – Depart at 6:00 pm

The town of Charlotte Amalie has one of the most breathtaking harbors in the world. Once home to pirates of long ago, today visitors find treasures of a different kind, for now beautiful beaches and bountiful duty-free shopping are truly its claim to fame.

Tortola, British Virgin Islands

Discovered by Christopher Columbus himself in 1493, this exotic, peaceful island is home to both towering mahogany trees and white-sand beaches. The region offers a challenging hike that extends 1,780 feet up Sage Mountain. A great spot for great birdwatching and breathtaking views of Tortola and neighboring islands.

- Enjoy free time relaxing on the boulder-strewn beach at Devil's Bay.
- Marvel at the natural beauty of the caves and hidden tidal pools on the way to The Baths.

When should I book shore excursions?

Do I need a passport?

U.S. citizens on homeport cruises (cruises that begin and end at the same U.S. port) are currently able to enter or depart the country with a state issued birth certificate with a raised seal and government-issued photo ID. While not required, AAA recommends traveling with an original, signed passport valid for 6 months beyond stay, and with at least one blank visa page for visa stamp(s).

How many bags can I bring?

One suitcase per person will be allowed. You may also bring a small carry-on bag.

Do I need travel insurance?

For your protection AAA highly recommends travel insurance. Pre-existing medical conditions may be waived with proper coverage only if travel insurance is purchased within 14 days of initial deposit. Other conditions may apply; ask your Travel Advisor. AAA recommends Allianz Insurance.

What will the weather be like?

Temperatures for the Eastern Caribbean in March average in the 80s with the evening temperatures in the low 70s. Casual clothes and comfortable walking shoes are recommended; be prepared for potential inclement weather
