Daily Itinerary

Sunday, September 20, 2026- Depart Central Pennsylvania – Albany, New York

Board your comfortable motorcoach this morning as we depart Central Pennsylvania for Albany, the scenic capital of New York State. Upon arrival, explore the New York State Museum—the oldest and largest state museum in the country—featuring exhibits on art, history, and natural science. Monday, September 21, 2026 – Albany – Lincoln, New Hampshire
