Thursday, July 15, 2027 - Depart Central PA for London, England

Your journey begins with a motorcoach transfer from Central Penn to a local international airport for an overnight flight* to London, England.

Friday, July 16, 2027 - Welcome to London!

Today is yours to explore the vibrant mix of old and new around every turn. Spend the day delving into the royal heritage of London, stroll along the tree-lined Thames or admire treasures from across the globe, before enjoying the night-time buzz of

this city. *Hotel: Hilton Kensington*

Saturday, July 17, 2027 - Journey to Stratford-upon-Avon and on to Leeds

Tuesday, July 20, 2027 - Venture into the Scottish Highlands

Flight

Activity Level

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need a passport? What about travel visas?

Yes, an original, signed passport valid for 6 months beyond stay, and with at least one blank visa page for visa stamp(s) is required for this trip. All travelers visiting or transiting through the United Kingdom (including England, Scotland, Wales, and Northern Ireland) are required to obtain a UK ETA (Electronic Travel Authorization). Please note that the UK ETA is not included in the cost of your trip, and it is the responsibility of each traveler to secure this authorization prior to departure. Please see your Travel Advisor for additional information.

Do I need travel insurance?

For your protection AAA highly recommends travel insurance. Pre-existing medical conditions may be waived with proper coverage only if travel insurance is purchased within 14 days of initial deposit. Other conditions may apply; ask your Travel Advisor. AAA recommends Allianz Insurance.

How many bags can I bring? What will the weather be like?

One suitcase per person will be allowed. You may also bring a small carry-on bag. Average temperatures in Britain for July average in the 60s-70s, possibly into the 80s during the day and 50s-60s in the evenings. Casual clothes that can be layered work best. Comfortable walking shoes and a small umbrella are recommended.
