Daily Itinerary

Sunday, October 3, 2027 - Depart Central PA and travel to Vancouver, British Columbia

Transfer by motorcoach from Central PA to a local international airport for a flight to Vancouver, British Columbia. Upon arrival settle into the hotel and enjoy the rest of the evening to rest or try one of the many fine dining Vancouver restaurants. Hotel: *Fairmont Hotel, Vancouver*

Monday, October 4, 2027 - Vancouver & The Vancouver Lookout

Explore downtown Vancouver on a tour encompassing landmark city sights, oceanfront vistas, architectural wonders and unbeatable views! Today's tour highlights include Stanley Park, English Bay, Granville Island, Robson Street, Gastown, Chinatown, Canada Place and admission to the Vancouver Lookout. Hotel: *Fairmont Hotel, Vancouver* (Breakfast)

Tuesday, October 5, 2027 - Vancouver to Kamloops- Rocky Mountaineer Train- GoldLeaf Service

Travel from the coastal city of Vancouver to Kamloops, in the heart of British Columbia's interior on the Rocky Mountaineer train! From the farmlands of the Fraser Valley to the steep canyons and desert landscape of British Columbia's interior, the landscape transformation is spectacular! Highlights include Hell's Gate, Cisco Crossing railroad bridges, and Kamloops Lake. Spend the evening exploring Kamloops or relaxing in your hotel room. Hotel: *TBD* (Breakfast, lunch, beverages, and snacks are included onboard the train)

Wednesday, October 6, 2027 - Kamloops to Lake Louise - Rocky Mountaineer Train- GoldLeaf Service

Board the Rocky Mountaineer train at the Kamloops Station to continue the journey east to the Canadian Rockies. Travel across ranchlands, along lakeshores, over mountain passes and through remarkable tunnels. Highlights include Craigellachie, Stoney Creek Bridge, Spiral Tunnels, and the Canadian Rockies Hotel: *Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise** (Breakfast, lunch, beverages, and snacks are included onboard the train.)

Thursday, October 7, 2027 - Lake Louise

Enjoy the day in Lake Louise to relax and explore the beautiful area. In the evening join the group for an included dinner at the Chateau. Hotel: *Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise* (Breakfast, Dinner)

Friday, October 8, 2027 - Lake Louise - Banff

Enjoy a full-day sightseeing tour of the Rocky Mountains. Highlights include Lake Louise, Yoho National Park, the Spiral Tunnels, Emerald Lake, Natural Bridge, Moraine Lake and Takakkaw Falls. This afternoon, enjoy lunch at the Emerald Lake Lodge. Hotel: *Fairmont Banff Springs* (Breakfast, Lunch)

**Note: Due to inclement weather and heavy snow fall, the road to Takakkaw Falls is periodically closed throughout the spring and fall season. Additional time will be spent at the Emerald Lake Lodge should this road be closed.*

Saturday, October 9, 2027 - Banff

Enjoy the day with free time to relax or explore Banff at your leisure. Hotel: *Fairmont Banff Springs* (Breakfast)

Sunday, October 10, 2027 - Banff - Calgary

Begin the morning with a sightseeing tour of Banff with highlights including Bow Falls, Surprise Corner and the Hoodoos. Before leaving Banff, enjoy a visit to the Banff Gondola where you'll climb Sulphur Mountain and get a bird's-eye view! Your tour concludes with an afternoon transfer to Calgary for an overnight stay. Hotel: *Fairmont Palliser Hotel, Calgary* (Breakfast)

Monday, October 11, 2027 - Depart Calgary, Alberta for flight to Central PA

After Breakfast, transfer to the Calgary Airport for your flight and transportation back to Central PA*. (Breakfast)

Activity Level:

Moderate: Good mobility is required for this trip. Climbing stairs and standing for 2-3 hours at a time, as well as walking on uneven terrain may be necessary. This activity level is not recommended for travelers with significant mobility concerns.

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Frequently Asked Questions

What Travel Documents Do I Need?

Original, signed passport valid for 6 months beyond stay, and with at least one blank Visa page for Visa stamp(s) is required for this trip. As travel policies are rapidly changing, final requirements will be communicated prior to departure. Please see your Travel Advisor for additional information.

*Canada reserves the right to deny entry to anyone with a felony conviction, including a DUI record. AAA is not responsible if you are denied entry to Canada and no refund will be provided.

Do I Need Travel Insurance?

For your protection, AAA recommends travel insurance. Pre-existing medical conditions may be waived with proper coverage if travel insurance is purchased within 14 days of initial deposit only. Other conditions may apply; ask your travel agent. AAA recommends Allianz.

What will the weather be like?

Temperatures in the Canadian Rockies for October average in the 40s and 50s with cooler mornings and evenings in the 30s. Casual clothes good for layering in order to be prepared for a variety of temperatures. Comfortable walking shoes are also recommended; be prepared for potential inclement weather.

How Many Bags May I Bring?

Due to limited space while touring, all passengers are limited to one checked bag no more than 50lbs. You may also bring a small carry-on bag small enough to fit under your seat. Soft sided carry-on bags no larger than 17in x 14in x 4in with a zippered enclosure are recommended. Wheeled carry-on cases that are used as carry-on luggage on airlines are too large and are not suitable as hand-carried luggage. Baggage fees are not included in the price of the trip. Baggage fees and other charges may be directly assessed by the airlines or airport.
