Daily Itinerary

Monday, November 1, 2027 - Depart Central PA for Overnight Flight to Reykjavick, Iceland

Your journey begins with a motorcoach transfer from Central Penn to a local international airport for an overnight flight to Reykjavik, Iceland!

Tuesday, November 2, 2027 - Reyjavick, Iceland

Welcome to Iceland's capital city, Reykjavík. Today, get acquainted with Old Town Reykjavík on a walking tour with a local guide to see the vibrant harbor, City Hall, the Parliament building, and the iconic Harpa Concert Hall with its stunning geometric glass façade. Gather with your fellow travelers at a popular restaurant for dinner featuring Icelandic cuisine. This evening, take an adventurous northern lights cruise** and sail into the darkness of Faxaflói Bay in search of the aurora borealis.* Hotel: *Centerhotel Plaza, Reykjavik* (Breakfast, Dinner)

***The northern lights cruise is weather-dependent and may be postponed or cancelled in the event of adverse weather or sea conditions.*

**The northern lights are in the Northern Hemisphere from September through April and are only visible when the sky is clear and free of clouds.*

Wednesday, November 3, 2027 - Reykjavik - Golden Circle - Vik, Iceland

After breakfast, travel the Golden Circle to see Geysir, the double-cascade Gullfoss Waterfall, and Thingvellir National Park, where you can stand on the crest of the Mid-Atlantic Ridge. In the afternoon, visit the Lava Exhibition Center before continuing to Seljalandsfoss, a rushing waterfall you may walk behind for a unique inside out view. Continue to Vík and begin three nights of aurora borealis searches in the countryside to increase your likelihood of seeing these elusive lights.* Hotel: *Hotel Dyrholaey, Vik* (Breakfast, Dinner)

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Thursday, November 4, 2027 - Vík - Reynisfjara - Vík, Iceland

Begin your day with a journey to Reynisfjara, the volcanic black sand beach famous for its basalt columns and rugged sea stacks just offshore. Connect with the resilient spirit of Iceland at the Skógar Museum, where its farm, domestic artifacts, and preserved turf-built houses bring rural Iceland to life. Afterward, stand in awe before the impressive Skógafoss Waterfall, one of Iceland's biggest and most beautiful waterfalls. Cap off your day with a visit to Sólheimajökull Glacier, Iceland's fourth-largest glacier. After dinner, gaze at the sky in search of the northern lights.* Hotel: *Hotel Dyrholaey, Vik* (Breakfast, Dinner)

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Friday, November 5, 2027 - Vik - Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon - Vik, Iceland

This morning, embark on a spectacular journey along the coast to the world famous Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon. Witness the breathtaking sight of an iceberg calving from a glacier and floating serenely towards the Atlantic Ocean. Keep an eye out for seals swimming in cold waters. Explore the "Diamond Beach," where ice sculptures from the lagoon wash ashore and glitter brilliantly against the stark black sand. After soaking in this unforgettable landscape, return to Vík. Following dinner, continue searching for the northern lights dancing across the night sky.* Hotel: *Hotel Dyrholaey, Vik* (Breakfast, Dinner)

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Saturday, November 6, 2027 - Vik - Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon - Vik, Iceland

Today, travel along the south shore towards the Reykjanes Peninsula. Known for its rugged landscape, lava fields, and numerous hot springs, the peninsula is home to the Blue Lagoon. Take a dip in the warm, mineral rich waters of the geothermal pool, located in the heart of a dramatic lava field. Return to Reykjavík for your farewell dinner and overnight stay. Hotel: *Centerhotel Plaza, Reykjavik* (Breakfast, Dinner)

Sunday, November 7, 2027 - Depart for Flight to Central PA

Today marks the end of this truly memorable journey through Iceland as we head to an International Airport for a flight* back to Central PA. (Breakfast)

Activity Level:

Frequently Asked Questions

What Travel Documents Do I Need?

Passport Required: Original, signed passport valid for 6 months beyond stay, and with at least one blank Visa page for Visa stamp(s) is required for this trip.

UK ETA: As of the publication of this brochure, all travelers visiting or transiting through the United Kingdom (including England, Scotland, Wales, and Northern Ireland) are required to obtain a UK ETA (Electronic Travel Authorization). This also applies to itineraries with layovers in the UK. Please note that the UK ETA is not included in the cost of your trip, and it is the responsibility of each traveler to secure this authorization prior to departure. Please see your Travel Advisor for additional information.

ETIAS: As of the printing of this brochure all guests are required to obtain an ETIAS (European Travel Information and Authorization System) travel authorization for travel to Europe's Schengen zone (not included in the price of the trip). Please see your Travel Advisor for additional information.

Travel Requirements: As travel policies are rapidly changing, final requirements will be communicated prior to departure. Please see your Travel Advisor for additional information.

Should I Have Travel Insurance?

For your protection AAA highly recommends travel insurance. Pre-existing medical conditions may be waived with proper coverage only if travel insurance is purchased within 14 days of initial deposit. Other conditions may apply; ask your Travel Advisor. AAA recommends Allianz Insurance.

When Should I Book Excursions?

Your AAA Travel Advisor is happy to help reserve your choice of optional excursions. It's best to book them as soon as possible as they can sell out.

What will the weather be Like?

Temperatures for Iceland in November average in the 30s and 40s for day and night time. Casual clothes that are good for layering and comfortable walking shoes are recommended; be prepared for potential inclement weather.

How Many Bags Am I Allowed To Bring?

Due to limited space while touring, all passengers are limited to one checked bag no more than 50lbs. You may also bring a small carry-on bag small enough to fit under your seat. Soft sided carry-on bags no larger than 17in x 14in x 4in with a zippered enclosure are recommended. Wheeled carry-on cases that are used as carry-on luggage on airlines are too large and are not suitable as hand-carried luggage. Baggage fees are not included in the price of the trip. Baggage fees and other charges may be directly assessed by the airlines or airport.
