Wednesday, July 7, 2027 - London, England

Transfer by motorcoach to a local airport for an overnight flight to London, England.

Thursday, July 8, 2027 - London, England

Transfer by motorcoach from airport to your hotel. Enjoy the day on your own in London. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel for a 2-night pre-cruise hotel stay*. *Hotel: Copthorne Tara Hotel, London, England*

**The hotel rooms may not be ready upon arrival. If they are not ready you can store your luggage at the hotel and explore the city until they are available.*

Friday, July 9, 2027 - London City Tour

This morning, enjoy breakfast at the hotel before meeting your guide for a sightseeing tour of London. Board your motorcoach and discover many of the city's landmarks. The day includes visits to the London Eye, offering spectacular views of the city skyline and the historic Tower of London. (Breakfast)

Saturday, July 10, 2027 - Embarkation Southampton Pier, England

Ship departs from the pier at 4:00pm.

Transfer by motorcoach from your hotel to the Southampton pier for embarkation on your ship, **SKY PRINCESS®** for your 7 night cruise. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Monday, July 12, 2027 - Haugesund, Norway

Arrive at 9:00AM – Departing at 5:00PM

This quaint town perched on the North Sea boasts dual personalities. While renowned as the site where Viking king Harald Hårfagre united Norway as a kingdom in the 9th century, it's also one of the country's most popular destinations for the annual Sildajazz Festival and Norwegian Film Festival. Add in a thriving town center with hundreds of shops and cultural diversions to jaw-dropping scenery and thrilling excursions, your stay in Haugesund promises to be an enthralling experience you won't soon forget. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

- Visit Mortholmen, historic coastal property. Located just a scenic one-hour drive from Haugesund, this over 100-year-old venue was once a bustling herring processing plant and is now a unique destination.
- The best way to get an insider's look at Haugesund is to follow the locals and go for an invigorating hike at Preikestolen, also known as the Pulpit Rock or Preacher's Rock, one of the most popular hiking trips in the region.
- Discover majestic fjords, cascading waterfalls, stunning glaciers, imposing mountains, and idyllic islands and lighthouses.

Tuesday, July 13, 2027 - Skjolden - Sognefjord (Scenic Cruising), Norway

Arrive at 8:00AM – Departing at 11:00PM

Situated in the heart of the Norwegian fjords, the port of Skjolden-Sognefjord is your gateway to a world of wonder: this land abounds with national treasures, thundering waterfalls, two UNESCO sites, ice-blue fjords hemmed in by sky-reaching mountains and scenery sounbelievably spectacular you just may lose your breath. From the ruggedly handsome mountains in Jotunheimen National Park to the humble stave churches that dot the landscape, this captivating area is yours to discover. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

- Visit one of the most dramatic cascading waterfalls, Asafossen Waterfall, via the winding Sognefjell National Tourist Route, the highest mountain pass in Northern Europe.
- Explore Norway's oldest and most highly decorated stave church, and learn about the wood crafting techniques at Ornes shipyard.
- Join a walking tour of Skjolden accompanied by a llama! Your three-hour adventure begins with a 20-minute guided walk past hydro quay, across the footbridge over the Fortun River, where you'll stop for photos and commentary then continue into the Morkrid Valley and on to a llama farm.

Wednesday, July 14, 2027 - Olden - Nordfjordind (Scenic Cruising), Norway

Arrive at 9:00AM – Departing at 9:00PM

By the mid-19th century, European travelers were cruising the waters of the Nordfjord and visiting the village of Olden. The Romantic Movement inspired this new taste for dramatic landscape – and Norway had plenty of dramatic landscape. Then as now, travelers were impressed, moved, and not frequently overwhelmed by the stark contrast between peaceful rural farmsteads and a towering wilderness of mountain peaks and glaciers. For many years Olden was home to American landscape artist William H. Singer (1868-1943). Scion of a Pittsburgh steel family, Singer provided Olden with a road and a regional hospital. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

- Come face-to-face with its rugged beauty beginning with a coach ride through the beautiful Olden Valley with its majestic mountains, glacier tongues, waterfalls and the green Olden Lake.
- Escape to the cool refuge of Lake Oldevatnet in a kayak and view Olden's majestic beauty from a different perspective.
- Head off the beaten path and take to the skies with a ride on the Loen Skylift, one of the world's steepest aerial ropeways.

Thursday, July 15, 2027 - Stavanger, Norway

Arrive at 10:00AM – Departing at 5:00PM

Norway's fourth largest city, Stavanger lies at the mouth of the Gandsfjord. The old port, attests to the sea's enduring role in Norwegian history. Here, Vikings once sailed on voyages of conquest and exploration. In later centuries, the port served as a major hub for Norway's mercantile and fishing fleets. By the mid-20th century, however, Stavanger had fallen on hard times as the fishing grounds dwindled. In 1969, the discovery of North Sea oil opened a new chapter in Stavanger's history. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

- Travel through time, getting a glimpse into Norway's ancient history, successful present and brilliant future. You'll travel through the rich farmland to Ullandhaug and the Iron Age Farm.
- Enjoy a narrated drive with marvelous views, intriguing history and a glimpse at Viking culture.

Friday, July 16, 2027 - At Sea Day

Relax and enjoy a day at sea while taking in the many amenities and activities aboard ship. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Saturday, July 17, 2027 - Disembarkation Southampton pier - Depart for Central, PA

Arrive at 7:00AM

Transfer by motorcoach from Southampton pier to London Heathrow Airport for your flight home to Central, PA. (Breakfast)

Activity Level:

Moderate: Good mobility is required for this trip. Climbing stairs and standing for 2-3 hours at a time, as well as walking on uneven terrain may be necessary. Portions of the itinerary may include higher altitudes. The itinerary may involve longer days

up to 12-14 hours in length. This activity level is not recommended for travelers with significant mobility concerns.

Frequently Asked Questions

What Travel Documents Do I Need?

Passport Required: Original, signed passport valid for 6 months beyond stay, and with at least one blank Visa page for Visa stamp(s) is required for this trip.

UK ETA: As of the publication of this brochure, all travelers visiting or transiting through the United Kingdom (including England, Scotland, Wales, and Northern Ireland) are required to obtain a UK ETA (Electronic Travel Authorization). This also applies to itineraries with layovers in the UK. Please note that the UK ETA is not included in the cost of your trip, and it is the responsibility of each traveler to secure this authorization prior to departure.

ETIAS: As of the printing of this brochure all guests are required to obtain an ETIAS (European Travel Information and Authorization System) travel authorization for travel to Europe's Schengen zone (not included in the price of the trip).

As travel policies are rapidly changing, final requirements will be communicated prior to departure. Please see your Travel Advisor for additional information.

Do I need Travel Insurance?

For your protection, AAA recommends travel insurance. Pre-existing medical conditions may be waived with proper coverage if travel insurance is purchased within 14 days of initial deposit only. Other conditions may apply; ask your travel agent. AAA recommends Allianz.

What will the weather be like?

Average temperatures for London and Norway in July are in the mid to upper 70s and 80s with cooler mornings and evenings in the mid 50s-60s. Pack for a variety of temperatures; layers are suggested. Daytime, casual clothes that are designed for warmer climates and breezy higher temperatures, as well as comfortable walking shoes are recommended. For cruising, evenings require casual or semi-formal attire, with two formal nights.

How Many Bags May I Bring?

One suitcase per person will be allowed. You may also bring a small carry on bag.
